Then okay, what instrument do you wanna play now?' (laughing) We're looking forward to the magic

And what happens with the music that gets created that day, during the session?

"I'm certain we'll get around to mixing it all down and putting it out for the public, but right now, we're just focused on enjoying that very day, those moments when the two of them are together and watching that synergy. And we want to give the fans an opportunity to watch these two work and play for an hour so they also can see and enjoy the process. We'll decide what to do with the music later on. Also, we will be posting clips from the session on-line, so that way the fans will get to see more."

Musician, artist and breakdancer, Gyasi Govan has also been invited to the session.
